- 2. Principal's Report: Katrina Longard
- a. **Fire Drill:** Saint Mary's completed their third Fire Drill of the year. Our next 3 are scheduled for April, May, and June 2024. Our staff and students were complimented for being among the quietest Fire Drills ever witnessed!
- b. **Remembrance Day School Ceremony:** our school-wide Remembrance Day Ceremony took place on Nov 8th, and was organized by Caitlin Wilson, our Music teacher. It was a solemn event, and the students of our school were respectful and involved. Two Grade 6 students were the Master or Ceremonies, and the Grade 4 and 2/3 classes put on beautiful performances centered around peace.
- c. **Risk Assessment Training:** Principals and senior staff in HRCE attended two full-days of training in November. Katrina explained this training involves how to look for and maintain safety for staff and students in difficult situations.
